Sub.: <u>Scrutinizer's Report on Postal Ballot Voting Process and E-voting Process conducted pursuant to the provisions of Section 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 22 and Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014.</u>

The Board of Directors of Indian Toners & Developers Limited has vide resolution passed on 23.5.2015 decided to conduct the process of voting through postal ballot for obtaining approval of shareholders of the Company for the resolutions as set out in the notice dated 23.5.2015 for 1) adoption of new set of Articles of Association of the Company inter-alia pursuant to the Companies Act, 2013, 2) providing mortgage of properties of the Company u/s 180 (1) (a) of the Companies Act, 2013 and 3) to make loan(s) to any person or other body corporate and/or give any guarantee(s)/provide any security(ies) in connection with loan(s).

The Company has provided the facility of voting through electronic means as required under the provisions of Rule 22 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 read alongwith provisions of Clause 30B (i) of the Listing Agreement as entered by the Company with BSE Limited.

I, Varanasi Hari, Proprietor of V. Hari& Co., was appointed as a Scrutinizer by Indian Toners & Developers Limited for the purpose of conducting the postal ballot voting process and e-voting process in a fair and transparent manner in respect of obtaining approval of shareholders of the Company for 1) adoption of new set of Articles of Association of the Company inter-alia pursuant to the Companies Act, 2013, 2) providing mortgage of properties of the Company u/s 180 (1) (a) of the Companies Act, 2013 and 3) to make loan(s) to any person or other body corporate and/or give any guarantee(s)/provide any security(ies) in connection with loan(s).

The management of the Company is responsible to ensure the compliance with the requirements of the Companies Act, 2013 and rules relating to voting through postal ballot and electronic means on the resolutions contained in the notice of postal ballot. My responsibility as a Scrutinizer for the postal ballot voting process and e-voting process is restricted to ensure that the voting process is conducted in a fair and transparent manner and make a scrutinizer's report of the votes cast "in favour' or "against" the resolutions stated above, based on the reports generated from the postal ballots received from the shareholders and e-voting system provided

- 3. All Postal Ballot Forms received upto 5.00 p.m. on Saturday, 29.8.2015, the last date and time fixed by the Company for receipt of Postal Ballot Forms were considered for my scrutiny for the purpose of this report.
- 4. The Postal Ballot Forms were kept in my safe custody.
- 5. The e-voting period remained open from 30th July, 2015 to 29th August, 2015.
- 6. At the end of the e-voting period, I have unblocked the electronic votes in the presence of two witnesses not in the employment of the Company.
- 7. The details containing list of shareholders who voted 'for' or 'against' the resolution put to vote was downloaded from the e-voting website of NSDL.
- 8. We have scrutinized the votes casted through electronic means and also through physical ballot forms for the purpose of this report.
- 9. The particulars of all the electronic votes casted by the shareholders through e-voting process and votes casted by the members through physical ballot forms have been recorded in a register separately maintained for the purpose.
